Directions

Apply a thin layer to clean, dry skin on face and neck. Allow gel to sit for 45-60 seconds. Begin to rub in a circular motion until gel balls up. If at first the gel doesn't ball up, wait an additional 30 seconds and start rubbing again. Continue rubbing until balls of dead skin, dirt, and oils accumulate. Rinse with warm water.

FAQ

Q. How does Exfolium Polishing Peel support skin health?

A. Exfoliation is an essential step in your skin care routine and in maintaining healthy skin. As we age, cell regeneration slows down. Exfoliation accelerates cell turnover, revealing newer, healthier skin cells, leading to a refined, even skin texture. Exfoliation helps prevent clogged pores, which can reduce breakouts and the marks they leave behind. Regular exfoliation can help reduce the appearance of fine lines and wrinkles, as well as leave your complexion looking brighter and healthier. Exfoliated skin can more effectively absorb serums and moisturizers. Exfolium Polishing Peel is the perfect way to promote skin health and a polished, perfected appearance.

Q. What is the difference between chemical exfoliation and physical exfoliation?

Chemical exfoliation uses ingredients like acids to gently dissolve and remove dead skin cells. Physical exfoliation is achieved through the mechanical action of scrubbing away dead skin cells. Exfolium Polishing Peel provides chemical exfoliation, but under this definition the term “chemical” doesn’t imply the use of harsh or synthetic ingredients. Exfolium uses naturally derived, skin-friendly acids like AHAs and BHAs to loosen the bonds between the dead surface cell layers and reveal the newer, more radiant skin underneath.

Q. How often should I use Exfolium Polishing Peel?

A. For normal to dry skin, incorporate Exfolium into your skin care routine once or twice a week to remove dry, dead skin cells. Over exfoliating can strip away essential oils which can lead to dryness or sensitivity. For combination to oily skin, use two three times a week to remove excess oil and dead cells and reduce clogged pores.

Q. When should I use Exfolium Polishing Peel.

A. Always cleanse before you exfoliate. Exfoliating in the morning can help balance skin’s sebum production, remove dead skin cells, and refresh your complexion for a brighter appearance throughout the day. Nighttime exfoliation allows the skin to renew and repair during the natural overnight regeneration process. Consider exfoliating at night if you have sensitive skin.

Q. What are the key benefits of Exfolium Polishing Peel?

A. Exfolium’s gentle exfoliating action removes dead skin cells to promote cell turnover and minimize the appearance of imperfections. Its polishing action evens the appearance of skin tone and reveals a youthful, perfected appearance.

Q. How long should I leave Exfolium Polishing Peel on my face?

A. After applying a thin layer to clean, dry skin, let the gel sit for 45-60 seconds. This is ample time for the actives to go to work, but if the gel doesn’t start balling up when you begin rubbing, let it sit for another 30 seconds or so. Use circular motions to rub up the gel into flaky balls of dead skin, dirt, and oils, then rinse completely with warm water.

Q Can I use Exfolium on my neck or other areas?

A. Yes! During your regular exfoliating facial, why not apply Exfolium Polishing Peel to your neck as well. In fact, other dry areas of the skin like elbows and heels can also benefit from regular exfoliation and polishing, so don’t forget to include them in your routine.
